Garden Conservancy Preservation Weekend, September 27-30, 2012

Beatrix Farrand Society Seminar, August 2013

The event will be a fund-raiser for the BFS and we expect a sell-out audience drawn from the preservation community, landscape architects, historians, gardeners, and others. We will be mounting a publicity campaign early next year. Carol Habermann and Howard Monroe have kindly volunteered to oversee hospitality and catering. More details to follow.
