Additional notes:

We were able to achieve some of our program-related goals for 2012:

- For the comfort of our guests, we added carpet pieces to the seats. This temporary solution has been superseded by the accession of about 60 stackable, padded chairs from Northeast Harbor Library, obtained for a nominal fee (\$75).
