I. Docent Committee Report

Between our Board Meeting on 5/24/2014 and our Board Meeting on 6/28/2014, we conducted two tours (including Docent Orientation) totaling 15 people.

Between our Board Meeting on 6/28/2014 and today, we have conducted two tours totaling 35 people.

The total number of people on docent-led tours for this Summer to date is 50.

We have referred an undetermined number of people from GCMtD Open Garden Day and other occasions to the BFS Open Days.

Income from these tours totals \$270 with a contribution from the Cohasset Garden Club coming in the mail. There were no charges for Docent Orientation and GCMtD Provisionals Orientation.
