The Beatrix Farrand Society Housekeeper Position Description

The Beatrix Farrand Society (BFS) Housekeeper is a year round position reporting to the BFS Vice President. The Housekeeper is responsible for ensuring that the Farrand addition at Garland Farm is maintained in a manner that is clean, neat and visually satisfying for our employees, volunteers and visitors.

Open channels should be maintained with the Caretaker and activities coordinated, as required.

The Housekeeper role for the Beatrix Farrand Society is defined as:

Before opening for the season and prior to the first board meeting:

Throughout, where needed:

- Use Mr. Clean Eraser on scuffs marks.
- Windex glass in French doors, cupboards, framed art
- Send drapes to cleaners
- Wash, iron and re-hang curtains

Entry, Library and Conference rooms:

- Use duster around upper wall & corners to remove spiders, webs, dust
- Clean inside windows, sills and outside sills
- Wipe down all woodwork (baseboards, door & window frames, inside sills, doors)
- Dust/wipe surface of furniture, lamps, bulbs, all bibelots
- Pull drawers from dressers and clean inside drawers, vacuum tracks and around feet for cobwebs, rodent leavings
- Remove books from shelves and clean shelves & dust books
- Vacuum floors and rugs
- Vacuum sofas and armchairs under cushions
- Wash exposed hardwood floor w/ Murphy Oil Soap and clean under rugs

Bathrooms:

- Use duster around upper wall and corners to remove spiders, webs, dust
- Clean inside windows, outside sills
- Wipe down all woodwork (baseboards, door & window frames, inside sills, doors)
- Wipe lighting and bulbs
- Scrub sinks, clean mirrors
- Vacuum and scrub floors

Kitchen:

- Use duster around upper wall and corners to remove spiders, webs, dust
- Clean inside windows, outside sills
- Wash all dishes, pots, pans, utensils
- Wipe down all woodwork (baseboards, door & window frames, inside sills, doors)
- Wipe cabinet fronts and inside cabinets and drawers
- Clean appliances
- Wipe counters
- Clean sinks
- Vacuum & scrub floor

Attic:

- Use duster around upper wall and corners to remove spiders, webs, dust
- Clean inside windows, outside sills
- Wipe down all woodwork
- Vacuum floor

Weekly:

- Dust
- Wipe down kitchen surfaces (counters, sink, appliances, and cupboard fronts)
- Clean bathrooms (toilet, sink, mirrors, and tub)
- De-cobweb corners as needed
- Windex glass tabletop surfaces
- Vacuum and mop all floors

Rotating throughout:

- A section of baseboard each week,
- Vacuum and dust behind furniture
- Dust library books
- Windex glassed art

After closing for the season and after the last board meeting:

- Clean inside closets and library office
- Check drawers for paper, cloth items (store in plastic)
- Clean fridge and empty of perishable items
- Clean oven and stove
- Clean kitchen thoroughly (cabinets fronts and counters)
- Stow window seat cushions away from sun and windows (away from dampness)
